- A sophomore planning to apply to become a Class of 2021 Clare Boothe Luce Scholar
- Intending on majoring in **computer science**
- Looking for potential research projects for summer 2019 through the computer science department

Then please:

1. Make contact with Prof. Iris Howley (iris@cs.williams.edu), CBL departmental representative for computer science, to let her know of your plans.
2. Fill out the general CBL application form (see CBL webpage), and submit to Dawn Schoorlemmer (ds10@williams.edu) by or before the Feb. 8 deadline.
3. Fill out the Computer Science summer research application form (<https://csci.williams.edu/files/CS-Summer-Research-Application4-2.pdf>) and submit it to Lauren Vining with a copy to Iris Howley. This form is due Feb. 18 – i.e., ten days after the CBL application is due.

Note that Computer Science faculty will be describing their research at a colloquium during winter study (January 24 at 2:35pm). You might find it helpful to attend that colloquium in order to get a broad sense of the research in the department.

Remember, you may apply to be a CBL scholar through more than one of the target departments, so please read the materials for each major/discipline through which you are planning to apply.

Even if your CBL scholars application is unsuccessful, there is still the possibility of being accepted into the summer science research program for 2019 to work in the computer science department. Decisions and offers for both the CBL scholars program and general summer research positions will occur in March.
